Reporting on the ministry of Evangelist Wilfred Makalanzi.

14/09/2016 – 20/10/2016

Dear Friends,

Wilfred has this last week returned from his ministry trip to the south west of Tanzania. His ministry is wonderfully blessed as he teaches, preaches and visit people in their homes. In many ways this reminds me of Charles Simeon, of Cambridge, who diligently visited people in their homes and taught and preached with great effect. Simeon knew the lives of the people to whom he preached. And they knew he cared for them!

Wilfred reports: I give praise to the Lord Jesus Christ our Saviour, and I thank God who gives me the strength I need to spread the Gospel.

This ministry trip commenced on 14/09/2016 at Matemanga Village. Nine days were spent doing house to house visitation, visiting about 176 people. This was followed by Seminars on the person and work of the Holy Spirit. 281 people attended. About 700 attended the evening crusades. 113 people accepted Jesus as Saviour and Lord.

From the 4/10/2016 to 20/10/2016 I was in the villages of Liwelo-Tundururu. Once again I commenced with house to house visitation, visiting people in 54 homes. This does take time as so many people have problems in their lives and ask so many questions. Many people attended the seminars, teaching on 'The Christian Life' and 'The Love of Jesus'. About 380 attended the seminars each day. The evening crusades were attended by about 1,000 people. A total of 420 people received Jesus as Saviour and Lord. There were 90 men and 330 women.

Thank you for your prayers and generous assistance for this ministry.
